

INFORMATION ABOUT SELF-ISOLATION

What should I do after getting tested?

If you have symptoms, you must return home immediately after the test.

You must wear a face covering on your way home.

Do not make any stops on your way. There is a risk that you could have Coronavirus (COVID-19) and could spread it to other people.

You must remain in self-isolation at home until you find out your test result.

There is no need for others in the house to quarantine unless you are confirmed to have coronavirus (COVID-19). If you are sharing a house with others, see 'What if I live with someone who is in quarantine?' go to www.dhhs.vic.gov/au/self-quarantine-cornavirus-covid-19 for information.

As always, we encourage anyone with symptoms to get tested, so if anyone you live with experiences symptoms they should get tested too.

If you have not received your results after 7 days, please call Banyule Community Health on 9450 2000.

If you test positive, whether or not you have symptoms, you must continue to self-isolate. You will be contacted by a public health worker from the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for advice on the next steps.
